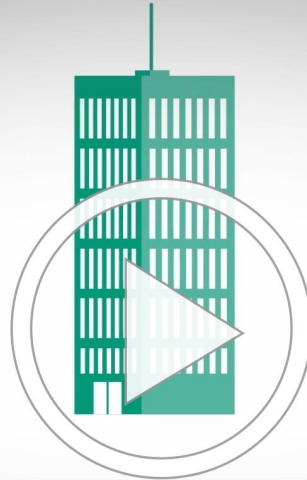

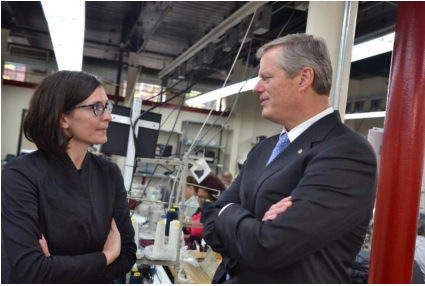

in advanced manufacturing. With 1 out every 4 jobs in Central Massachusetts being in the manufacturing sector, The efforts of the consortium are feeding this much needed industry pipeline.

Employment in Manufacturing makes up 25,800 of the jobs in North Central MA. Over the next five years, it is projected that there will be 8,600 jobs available due to retirements and attrition within the manufacturing industry. Manufacturing is a high priority sector across the commonwealth with both governmental and local support, now is a prime time to get involved.

Working Toward The Future

At the MassHire North Central Workforce Board (MHNCWB), it is our mission to increase youth employment in the region. The current summer rate of employment for 16 to 19 years old is at 60% which means many youth

are without jobs. We strongly believe young adults who obtain employment learn essential life skills including: patience, compromise, teamwork, and how and when to take initiative while working a part time job. We know when youth begin working at an early age, their life time earnings are higher than those who do not work. Employment at an early age is a building block for their future of gainful employment into adulthood.
